C-13 Canal Greenway Trail

Amenities

- One-mile asphalt trail for pedestrians and bicyclists
- Scenic and panoramic views of the C-13 Canal

The C-13 Canal Greenway Trail is a mile-long, multi-use trail that runs along the northern end of the South Florida Water Management District's C-13 Canal, between State Road 7 and NW 31st Avenue in the City of Lauderdale Lakes. The trail is the ideal place for one to relax, reflect, and rejuvenate the mind, body and soul.

Northgate Neighborhood Park

- Two outdoor basketball courts
- Covered playground
- Half-mile jogging path
- Medium size pavilion (accommodating 30-35 people)
- Large pavilion (accommodating 50-60 people)
- Rest room building

Opened in 2007, this 3.19 acre park offers a variety of options for sport and leisure opportunities. Among its amenities include open air shelters, rest rooms, a half-mile jogging path, covered play areas, two basketball courts and an open field for other recreational activities.

This community center offers a variety of spaces and facilities for the recreational enjoyment of residents and their guests. It features a number of classrooms, picnic pavilions, an auditorium/banquet room, and a fitness center. Rental opportunities are available for private functions.

Cypress Preserve Conservation Park

- Pedestrian path and walking trail with seating
- Two pavilions with barbecue grills
- Natural landscaping with native plant material
- Butterfly gardens
- Bicycle rack
- Rest rooms and water fountain

The city's first conservation park, this 6.38-acre park was made possible by land donated from Broward County specifically for the purpose of preserving environmentally sensitive lands and expanding passive recreation opportunities. Enjoy a nature walk and take in the views of our butterfly gardens along the way.
